- Evidence of experience with delivering sport and education to young people
- A robust plan to deliver a long-term project to benefit young people including an outline budget
- Plan to work with underrepresented groups within rowing
- Clarity on how the bursary will be targeted to support 11-18 year olds
- Demonstrate how life skills are going to be taught as part of the project
- Clear reporting structure to show the impact of the bursary support after 6 months and 12 months
- Consideration as to how you aim to continue your project when the bursary grant is spent
